#### 1. Standards challenged in a particular way:

## Standard 55

You must ensure that

- (a) the text of each page of your website is available in Welsh,
- (b) every Welsh language page on your website is fully functional, and

(c) the Welsh language is not treated less favourably than the English language on your website.

#### Standard 58

If you have a Welsh language web page that corresponds to an English language web page, you must state clearly on the English language web page that the page is also available in Welsh, and you must provide a direct link to the Welsh page on the corresponding English
